Minutes of March 6, 2024

Meeting called to order by Secretary Hiscox, 7:32 PM

- Visitors: Tim Delucia, A.D. Norwich Tech. Tim asked if it would be possible for the Norwich Tech J.V. Baseball team to use the Franklin Senior League Field 2-3 days/week from 2:30-4:30 +/- PM for practices. The usage would begin the week of March 18 and continue to approximately the end of May. Tim offered a COI naming the Town of Franklin and the labor of dragging or raking the field after usage.
 - Scott D offered a Motion to approve the usage of the SLBB Field by Norwich Tech contingent on the receipt of a valid COI. The Motion was seconded by Rich H and passed unanimously without further discussion.

 - Lee J reported that the Monday Rec Runs would continue in 2024. They will begin Monday July 1 and continue the following 7 weeks. These will start with the youth runs at 6:30 PM.
 - O Greg B put forth a Motion to authorize Lee J to spend up to \$500 on the usual awards that are given out to the runners for various divisions and results. This Motion was econded by Scott D and passed without discussion or dissent.
 - o Rich H reported that the Music in the Park Program would continue this summer with tentative dates of June 8, July 13, August 10, and Sept 14.
 - O Scott D opened a discussion regarding the possible lighting of Volunteer field. Dave Lunt has acquired the fixtures needed but there would be significant expenses for Poles, a new service, and installation. Scott, and Dave separately, are in discussions with Eversource to see what may be donated in either labor and/or materials.
 - Rich H brought up the need to finalize and submit a proposed Budget for the 2024-25 Fiscal Year. After some spirited discussions the FRC Budget request would be slightly over the recommended 10% increase but will contain several CIP Requests totaling \$312,500. A copy of the agreed upon 2024-25 Budget Request is attached to these Minutes.


